SUB: RECALL OF CIRCULAR DATED 20.05.2024

Respected Sir,

Several concerns were earlier raised by the Executive Committee of the SCAORA, regarding the listing of matters before the Hon'ble Supreme Court during the ongoing Summer Vacations, 2024 and wherein certain emergent directions were solicited from your end to the Registry, to ensure that while the matters are taken up by the respective Benches in the Summer Vacation, no member of the Bar faces any inconvenience as well, and the listing of matters and their adjudication is streamlined for all concerned.


However, a Circular dated 20.05.2024 has been issued stating that some of the matters that were either not ready for listing or are connected matters will not be listed on notified dates. These matters will either be listed in the later part of the vacation with advance notice, if found in order or along with their main matters, whenever the main matter is listed.

It is asserted that the summer vacations have already begun and most of the members of the bar have planned their summer break, in line with the vacation bench list. Therefore, any change in the same after the last working day will cause unnecessary stress and discomfort to the lawyers.

As a matter of fact, most of the members of the bar have left for their home town, therefore it is neither feasible nor practical to issue such changes at the last hour.

You are therefore requested to recall the Circular dated 20.05.2024 at the earliest.
