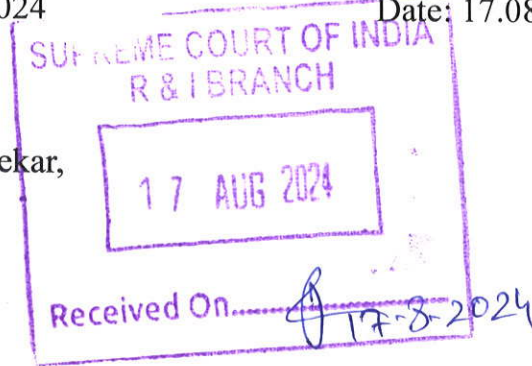

OPPOSITE COUNSEL IN THE MENTION LIST.


Respected Sir,

It has come to our attention that there has been an unwarranted difficulty faced by the members of the bar as regards the current format of mentioning list. The current format of mentioning list only indicates the name of the counsel, who mentions the matter before the Hon'ble Court while excluding the name of all the AoRs in the matter. This often leads to difficulties faced by the opposite counsel to track their cases or reach the Court on time for mentioning. The current system is therefore creating an impediment to the idea propagated by the Hon'ble Chief Justice of India for the smooth functioning of the justice administration in the Hon'ble Apex Court.

Considering this genuine problem, please issue directions to the registry to make and prepare the list along with the names of all the AoRs (in the concerned matter) in the mentioning list on an urgent basis. This will not only help them to effectively track their cases without any adversity but also save the precious time of the Hon'ble Court by avoiding any adjournment for want to knowledge and preparation.
